Notice to Producers

2019 Incentive Days CANNOT be used in December

In order to better align production with the Western Milk Pool, SaskMilk is announcing that the 2019 Incentive Days CANNOT be used in December 2019. SaskMilk continues to monitor processing capacity and demand to ensure that the milk produced in Saskatchewan is keeping with responsible production volumes. With current projections, Incentive Days should not be needed in December.

There is no change to the use of Incentive Days in September, October, and November. The total number of available incentive days (10 days) has not changed. The monthly limit of 3 incentive days remains in effect.
