## **2020 Incentive Days Notice – Flexible Incentive Days**

To better align production with the Fall high-demand period, and to provide adequate notice for producers to plan in order to fill the days, we are announcing next year's incentive days.

In order to give farms better tools to manage their production, and allow greater flexibility, producers will again have the opportunity to determine when the incentive days are produced during the five-month period of August to December. That is, the Board will not specifically allocate days per month but will provide maximum production limits.

Producers will be allowed a **total of ten (10) incentive days** between August and December, with the following monthly limits:

<b>August</b>	<b>maximum of 3 days</b>	} <b>The total number of days from August to December cannot exceed 10 days</b>
<b>September</b>	<b>maximum of 3 days</b>	
<b>October</b>	<b>maximum of 3 days</b>	
<b>November</b>	<b>maximum of 3 days</b>	
<b>December</b>	<b>maximum of 3 days</b>
