**Credit Restrictions Lifted Effective September 1<sup>st</sup>**  
**Underproduction Penalties Reinstated Effective October 1<sup>st</sup>**  
**September Incentive Days CANCELLED**

SaskMilk and the WMP have been closely watching the markets and processing to determine adjustments that need to be made to supply. Fall milk is still needed, and it is important that the WMP is able to fill demand. However, impacts from the Covid-19 pandemic and uncertainties in the market remain.

In order to minimize potential costs and skimming/disposal, SaskMilk has decided to lift credit restrictions beginning in September.

**Effective September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020, the production restriction is lifted. Producers may produce their credits normally (with no restrictions nor incentive days applying), subject to the normal -15 to +5 range.**

**Underproduction (lost opportunity/under -15 days) financial penalties, quota issuance holdback penalties, or penalties restricting credit transfers will be reinstated, effective October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.**

**September incentive days are cancelled. Further information regarding future incentive days will be sent in the coming weeks.**

Please remember that any production over +5 days will incur deductions of a \$100 base administration fee plus \$5/kg.

SaskMilk and the WMP will continue to closely evaluate the market situation and will make further changes as new information becomes available.
